# About the John R. Evans Leaders Fund (JELF)

- Attract and retain the very best of today's and tomorrow's researchers
- Universities are eligible if they have received a minimum annual average of \$200,000 over three years from the three federal research funding agencies
- Each university has an allocation based on the share of tri-agency funding
- Up to three faculty members that work collaboratively using the same requested infrastructure, or work independently while sharing the requested infrastructure










# Eligible infrastructure

- Acquisition or development of research infrastructure to increase research capacity and enable innovative research activities
- Facilities, laboratories, equipment, computer hardware, software, and databases
- Including workhorses and upgrade or replacement of aging infrastructure
- From \$75,001 to \$800,000 in CFI request (up to \$2M in total cost due to max of 40% from CFI)
- Exceptions to minimum for SSH and smaller institutions









## Review criteria



### Review process


- Less than or equal to \$400,000
  - Minimum of two experts who provide a written review to the CFI
- More than \$400,000 to \$800,000
  - Expert committee
- Québec projects
  - Expert committee by the Government of Québec






